

DANCER CODE OF CONDUCT 2025

As a dancer at Claudia Sophia Dance, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct to ensure that everybody feels safe and enjoys their time with us.

Anyone failing to meet behaviour standard will be dealt with at the discretion of teachers at Claudia Sophia Dance.

- Be respectful at all times, regardless of ability, cultural background, religion, gender or any other protected characteristic.
- Be supportive of all fellow dancers (positive, encouraging words and applause for demonstrations)
- Give best effort possible on that day in class.
- Bring a positive approach to class and learning.
- Promote any social media (X, Instagram, Facebook, TikTok, etc) positively and show support to fellow dancers.
- Help create an inclusive and creative environment in class.
- Will not participate in any bullying, discrimination or negative behaviour towards fellow dancers in class or through social media.
- All dancers must practice and follow class structure, respecting the teachers and their decisions.
- Dancers must make every effort be at class on time to be in the studio and ready at the allocated start of class time.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance and use appropriate language whilst involved with dance class activities.
- Dancers should be dressed appropriately for class, in comfortable clothing which they can move in (e.g. t-shirt/tops/hoodies/jackets and sports shorts/leggings/trousers) and clean/dry trainers/dance shoes (please bring shoes for using in class especially if wet/snowing outside. No open toe shoes e.g. flip-flops, sandals, crocs, sliders).
- NO jewellery is to be worn in class.
- Bullying or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated and will be dealt with at the discretion of the teachers and Child Protection Officer.
- Communication is key to ensure each dancer's safety and happiness within the classes.

We encourage dancers to approach any member of Claudia Sophia Dance teaching team with any concerns, worries or exciting developments within or outside of the dance classes.
